1 Car Park: Parking spaces for 200 cars.

★ Parking for Coaches, Minibuses and the disabled.

2 Entrance: Tickets and entrance to the farm. You can also buy chick feed here from the shop.

3 Goats: Four different breeds of goat are housed here. See Information Boards for more details.

4 Chicks: These are kept here from birth to three weeks old.

5 Small Animals: Rabbits, Chipmunks, Guinea Pigs and ferrets. See Information Boards for more details.

6 Play/picnic Area:

Large picnic area with play area for children from 3 years - 8 years under supervision.

7 Hens and Bantams

8 Sheep: Old breed.

9 Ponies/Donkeys: The Shetland Ponies and the Donkeys live here.

10 Wildfowl Area: Approach the hides quietly and see what you can see!

11 The Picnic Plantation: See how many varieties of trees/bushes you can spot whilst enjoying your picnic.

12 Outdoor Pigs: See the pigs having a great time wallowing in the mud!

13 Sheep: These Ewes lamb in early springtime.

14 Pigs: Piglets and their mums.

15 Milking Area: School Parties welcome. Demonstrations daily at 2.30pm. 1.30pm during termtime.

16 Blacksmiths: See a working forge and the ironcrafts display.

17 Cows and Calves

18 Duck Pond: Feed the ducks, guinea fowl, pigeons and doves.

19 Young Animals: There are demonstrations here during springtime when the lambs are bottle fed by staff.

20 Shire Horses: The friendly giants.

21 Cattle: Various breeds.

22 Aviary: Pheasants, bantams & turkeys.

23 Exhibition Area: Natural History display - Birds, local mammals and insight into the wildlife of the Farm.

24 Indoor Picnic Area: Available for DIY childrens birthday parties (to book contact the farm office).

25 Play Barn: Fergie the little red tractor!

26 Shop: Souvenirs, refreshments and ice-creams.
